## The Vineries

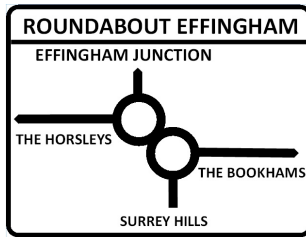
