### Freedom of information requests to Surrey County Council

Reference: W1001364 Date 13/11/14 presented at original application.

#### 1. Current demand for places at The Howard.

The appellant asserts that the school needs to be enlarged to accommodate existing and forecast need, and the need generated by the proposed development. Information acquired from Freedom Of Information Requests to Surrey County Council, refutes this assertion. (ref: W1001364 13/11/14)

- I. In every year since information has been recorded in 2010, after meeting all aspects of its admissions criteria for cared for and looked after children and siblings, SCC confirms that "Every child who applied and lived in catchment area got a place at the school"
- II. In fact, the majority of all children placing The Howard as their 1<sup>st</sup> choice school, regardless of catchment area and admissions procedures, achieve a place at the school.
